The application's main features include remote payment to pay or renew parking fees for the desired parking space and length of time, the option of receiving an alert before the parking period expires, and printable receipts that can be sent by email. You can now bring the parking meter to your phone by downloading the free *P\$ Mobile Service* application from the <u>App Store</u>, <u>Android Apps by Google Play</u> or <u>BlackBerry App World™</u>, or visit <u>pservicemobile.ca</u> for more information. Motorists can also download the application on their smartphones by scanning the QR code displayed on street-level parking meters.
